

Links to historical aerial photos –

One excellent (and free) source of historical aerial photos as well as other imagery is EarthExplorer provided by the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) and located at <https://earthexplorer.usgs.gov/> The user interface is simple to use and results come up quickly.

Do not assume the aerial photos are always oriented with north at the top of the image. It may be necessary to rotate the image to get it (close to) oriented to cardinal directions.
